Carl and Johnny are greeted by the locals who they saved from the Brawlers. The are grateful for the rescue, and the youngest of them offers the boys a drink.





Carl and Johnny educate the locals on tactics, traps, and firearms. They decide to teach them a three-pronged tactic—outrun, if you can't outrun then outwit, and if that fails, then outgun your opponents.




Carl sets up an obstacle course in a pre-designated alley, and plans to draw some of the Brawlers in to demonstrate the tactics that can be used to help you outrun an angry mob, vicious gang, or whatever else may be chasing you.




Carl jumps a fence in the alley, and will lead the Brawlers to a tripwire that he set to stop them. A few of the Brawlers were taken out by spilled garbage cans, oil slicks, and hopefully the fence.



In the Outwit segment, Carl leads the Brawlers on a chase through an abandoned construction site, where he takes a convoluted route to confuse them, and then drops a bag of marbles to trip them up.



When Carl leads them to the rooftop, the Brawlers get an unexpected surprise. Carl has set up a bungee cord that he clips into and jumps off the roof.



Carl jumps off the roof and then salutes the Brawlers on his way down. If they have any thoughts of using the cord to follow him, their hopes are dashed when Carl cuts the bungee cord and runs off.



Johnny starts the firefight by shooting two of the Brawlers. As the action ramps up everyone will get in on the action.
